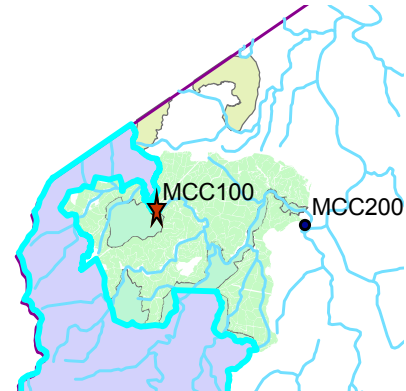


Cotter Catchment: Condor Creek

State of the Stream

- Two sharp phosphate spikes in October-November 2005, and February-March 2006
- Unfavourably high water temperatures in summer indicate a need for increased riparian shading.
- Plenty of animal life
- Recovering native shrubbery and some weeds present
- Algal cover is low in tufts on rocks and snags.
