Platypus Month is celebrating its 10th year! Waterwatch will be running group surveys throughout August on selected rivers in the ACT region to help learn more about our platypus population. Late winter is the ideal time for spotting platypus as they spend more time feeding and the males are more active as they prepare for the breeding season.

Waterwatch will be conducting **34 surveys** throughout August and need your help! **No experience necessary.**
